## Council Update - In August, Council:

- postponed the vote on a motion to tender the construction of the District of Lantzville and City of Nanaimo water system connection, and for a related Financial Plan Bylaw Amendment, to the September 12, 2016 regular Council meeting or an earlier special Council meeting after receipt of a conflict of interest legal opinion.

## Have you paid your Property Taxes?

**September 29, 2016** – Last day to pay for 2016 property taxes (due on or before Monday, July 4, 2016) to avoid second 5% penalty. Outstanding amounts due to Home Owner Grants not being claimed by these dates are subject to the same penalty.

**Tax Sale - September 26, 2016** – Property tax accounts with three years of unpaid taxes as of the last Monday in September are subject to tax sale which, if required, will take place in the Council Chambers, District Office, 7192 Lantzville Road, Lantzville, BC on Monday, September 26<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 am. Properties in a tax sale are advertised in the newspaper.

## Traffic Notes – Temporary Road Closure!

A portion of Lantzville Road (north of Ware Road to Huddlestone Road) will be closed from 9:45am-11am for the September 10<sup>th</sup> Minetown Day parade. Traffic control will be present during the closure to redirect traffic through Lantzville via alternate routes. Expect traffic delays, obey all directions given by traffic control, and please use caution with the increased pedestrian traffic.
