Parks Improvement Updates

Rotary Park – Work on the mountain bike skills circuit proceeded in November as far as possible until we have better weather when compaction can take place. NOTE: Circuit is tarped and cannot be used until compacted.

Huddleston Park – Subject to playground equipment replacement funding approval, the Parks and Recreation Commission will begin the public input process by consulting with Lantzville school children in December 2017 and a public survey in January 2018.

Council Update - In November, Council:

- directed staff to prepare a report on sewer charge alternatives, including the linkage to water usage
- authorized items for staff to include in the 2018-2022 Financial Plan Bylaw for Council consideration
- authorized an increase to the firefighter member rates effective January 1, 2017 equivalent to the CUPE Local 401 Lantzville rate increase for 2017 (2%)
- appointed Councillor Coulson as member and Councillor Geselbracht as alternate on the VI Regional Library Board serving until December 31, 2018
- authorized staff to apply to the Federation of Canadian Municipalities for grant funding for the Asset Management Plan development and implementation
- requested an annual report (coinciding with budget cycle) on legal fee expenditures general topics
- directed staff to prepare bylaws for new water connections and water system expansion fees for Council's consideration
- appointed Economic Development Strategic Plan Community Branding Select Committee members
- gave first three readings to 2018-2022 Financial Plan Bylaw No. 147 and Development Cost Charge Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw No. 149
- approved the Council Chamber Audio Visual and recording equipment (\$11,850) replacement/upgrade
- adopted the Water Master Plan
- authorized the CAO to contract an Internal Service Capacity Review (\$55,000) to Judy Rogers Consulting
- approved a general bus shelter design and for staff to work with volunteers to construct the bus shelter near 7217 Lantzville Road if funding is raised to cover 50% of the costs and with the District funding 50%, if required, from surplus
- approved issuance of a Development Permit for 6940/6942 Dickinson Road to accommodate subdivision in a steep slope area
- referred the draft Council Committee System Policy to a Committee of the Whole meeting in January 2018.
