Updated: March 2016

- **Micro and Drip Irrigation:** "Delivers water to the root zone of the plants and uses less than 20 gallons per hour at less than 25 psi."
- Hand-watering: "Delivering water by hose with spring-loaded nozzle shut-off device or hand-held container."

Note: We encourage all residents to voluntarily conserve water at all times. Water restrictions only apply to those property owners who are on the District's community water system. However, we also encourage those property owners on individual private wells to also exercise conservation measures when it comes to water usage.
