## Volunteer Vacancies Official Community Plan Review Select Committee

The primary purpose of this advisory Committee is to assist with ensuring that community members have the opportunity to provide input and feedback throughout the process, and to provide feedback on decision points, as required. A public workshop to discuss the OCP and Water Master Plan is scheduled to be held on November 2, 2016 at 6:00 pm at Costin Hall – all members of the Committee will be expected to attend. This event will explore potential directions for both plans.

Appointments are on a volunteer basis and members serve without remuneration. The Committee will meet once a month commencing on November 9, 2016 at 6:00 pm. Future meeting times will be confirmed by the Committee at the first meeting.
