**NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND
COUNCIL PROCEDURE BYLAW NO. 141, 2020**

In accordance with Section 124(3) of the *Community Charter*, notice is hereby given that the District of Lantzville Council intends to amend "Council Procedure Bylaw No. 141, 2020" by considering adoption of "Council Procedure Bylaw No. 141, 2020, Amendment Bylaw No. 371, 2024" on June 26th, 2024. In general terms, the proposed amendment would change the following:

- The unanimous consent to 2/3 affirmative vote of the members present to:
 - I. hold meetings past 9:30 pm; AND
 - II. to add late items [referring to items that were not on the published agenda] without a written report.
- Removing the language stating that agenda items are reviewed and approved by the CAO and replacing it with language that states all submitted items must be included on the agenda, unless legislatively improper
- Reordering the agenda for meetings to enable the closed portion of Council meetings to occur at the end of the public portion of the meeting so that, generally, public meetings will begin at 6:00 pm

If you believe your interests are affected by the proposed bylaw, you may express your views to Council at the June 26th, 2024, Council meeting. If you cannot attend the meeting, you may fax or write to Council at the address below or send an e-mail to district@lantzville.ca, before 12 noon on Wednesday, June 26th, 2024. Your submission will become part of the public record.
