

# 2024 School Trustee By-Election

**PUBLIC NOTICE** is given to the electors of School District No. 68 (Nanaimo Ladysmith Public Schools) that the by-election voting day is Saturday, September 14, 2024. Candidates shall be nominated in writing by two duly qualified electors of School District No. 68 (Nanaimo Ladysmith Public Schools). The nomination documents shall be in the form prescribed in the *Local Government Act* and shall state the name and residence of the person nominated in such a manner as to sufficiently identify such candidate.

**Nominations for the office of:** One (1) Trustee elected at large, for the remainder of the 4-year term (ending November 2026), will be received by the Chief Election Officer or a designated person, as follows:

Candidates wishing to file nomination documents should call Karen Matthews, Deputy Chief Election Officer, at 250-741-5231 to make an appointment for filing.

At the time of filing the nomination documents, the candidate shall also file with the Chief Election Officer or a person designated by the Chief Election Officer a written disclosure, as required under the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*.



## Qualifications for Office

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a School Trustee if they meet the following criteria:

- ▶ Canadian citizen;
- ▶ 18 years of age or older on voting day (September 14, 2024);
- ▶ Resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed;
- ▶ Not disqualified under the School Act or any other enactment from being nominated for, being elected to or holding office as a trustee, or be otherwise disqualified by law.
