DISTRICT OF LANTZVILLE DICKINSON ROAD CULVERT REPLACEMENT

Signed Tender Forms in sealed envelopes marked “Tender for District of Lantzville, Dickinson Road Culvert Replacement” will be received at the District of Lantzville Municipal Hall at 7192 Lantzville Road, PO Box 100, Lantzville, B.C. V0R 2H0, up to 2:00:00 pm local time, on Thursday November 14th, 2024, after which time they will be opened in public.

The work includes the supply of all materials, labour, and equipment to:

- Remove the existing CSP culvert and headwalls,
- Install approximately 16 lm of concrete box culvert, related appurtenances and associated surface restoration.
