READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE COMPLETING THE APPLICATION FORM

- a. The date the application is being submitted must be filled out to be accepted.
- b. All full legal names of the applicant must be filled out. The full legal names must match the identification provided.
- c. Print the street address or legal description of the applicant's real property in relation to which the applicant is registering. The applicant must attach satisfactory proof they are entitled to register in relation to the real property referred to on the application form (ex: certificate of title)
- d. Print the applicant's mailing address including street number and name, as well as the city and postal code.
- e. Print either the last 6 digits of the applicant's social insurance number or the applicant's birthdate. This information is required pursuant to the *Local Government Act*.
- f. If applicable, please fill out any previous legal names if the applicant's name has changed since previously registering as a non-resident property elector.
- g. The Applicant must declare that they meet all the requirements listed on this form to register as a non-resident property elector.
- h. The Applicant must sign the Non-Resident Property Elector Registration Form in the presence of a witness.
- i. The witness to the applicant's signature must sign the application form.
- j. Please print the residential address of the witness.
- k. You must attach the "Non-Resident Property Elector Consent Form" if the land title registration of the real property in relation to which a person is registering indicates that there is more than one individual who is the registered owner of the real property. The person may only register as a non-resident property elector with the written consent of the number of those individuals who, together with the person registering, are a majority of those individuals.
- l. If person is registering at the time of voting, 2 pieces of identification are required. One piece of identification must have a signature to prove identity.
