**Low Flush Toilet
Rebate Program**

Many homes are equipped with older toilets that require 13 or more litres per flush. New low flush toilets require only 6 litres per flush and dual flush toilets use between 3 to 6 litres.

By replacing your old toilet, you could use up to 1/3 less water. That could save more than 200 litres per day or 70,000 litres per year. (WOW!)

For a limited time, the District of Lantzville is offering a lifetime maximum of two (2) rebates per residence. Replacing toilets using 13 litres or more, with a CSA approved new low flush model will earn you a rebate. The rebate is \$60 for a low flush model (6 litres) & \$100 for a dual flush model (3/6 litres). Rebate for new construction is \$40.

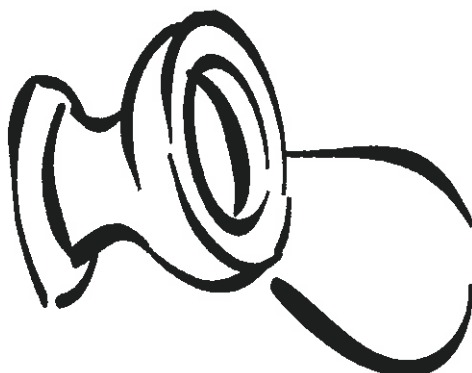

Why is Lantzville Initiating this Program?

We want to reduce water consumption. There is a long term trend of diminishing water levels in the Quadra Sands aquifer, which is Lantzville's only water supply. It costs money to treat and supply the water going to your house. Using less water saves money and is better for the environment. By cooperating in this initiative you will ultimately save Lantzville money and more importantly, assist in keeping water rates down.



Who is eligible?

This offer is only available to residents and/or property owners of the District of Lantzville who are connected to the community water system (lifetime limit of 2 toilet rebates per residence). Simple toilet replacements **DO NOT** require a plumbing permit. However, if you are performing renovations, you must apply for a building permit.



New Construction?

For new construction in the District of Lantzville, low flush (6 litres) toilets are encouraged. The District of Lantzville will provide a \$40 rebate for those property owners who install dual flush toilets (3/6 litre) as an alternative to the low flush models. There is no maximum for this incentive.

How do I choose a good, low flush toilet?

There are many web sites and retailers to assist in your decision. Staff at the District Office are not in a position to recommend toilets. Toilets may be installed by the resident or by a licensed plumber. Low flush toilets install just like any other toilet.

How do I apply?

Application forms are on the reverse side of this information brochure or you may download an application from the District's website @ www.lantzville.ca.

Then simply ...

- provide a receipt (dated after July 31, 2005) for the purchase of a CSA-approved low flush toilet.
- Provide proof of installation of the new low flush or dual flush toilet and the removal/destruction of the old toilet as follows:
 - photo of old toilet in place
 - photo of old toilet removed & tank broken
 - photo of the new low flush toilet in place

NOTE: You must agree to permit a representative of the DOL to access your property to inspect the installation if requested.

How do I dispose of my old toilet?

For a small fee, old toilets may be disposed of at the Regional District of Nanaimo Landfill (Cedar) or the Transfer Station located on Church Rd (Parksville).

Application Approval Process

District of Lantzville staff will review your application and, if you qualify, mail you a cheque for \$60 (low flush toilet) or \$100 (dual flush toilet). REMINDER ... only two toilets per residence are eligible for the rebate.

Please be advised that submission of an application does not guarantee a rebate and REMEMBER ... the rebate program is for a limited time only.
