Happy Thanksgiving!

The District Office will be closed for Thanksgiving Day on Monday, October 10, 2016. Regular hours (8:00 am - 4:00 pm) will resume on Tuesday, October 11, 2016.

Council Update – In September 2016, Council:

- endorsed the Canadian Cancer Society's recommendation that the Province expand the *Tobacco and Vapour Products Control Act* to provide smoke and vape-free outdoor public places
- consented to the Regional District of Nanaimo Board adopting the Southern Community Sewer Local Service Amendment Bylaw No. 888.07
- directed staff to tender the construction of the pipeline to connect to the City of Nanaimo water
- authorized expending \$5,972 for additional audio video equipment for the Council Chamber
- adopted Water Asset Replacement Reserve Fund Transferring Bylaw No. 129, 2016
- approved the 2017 Council meeting schedule
- authorized expending the Province's \$3,000 grant for 2016 Copley Ridge Recreation Trail projects
- approved the OCP Review Select Committee
- announced the increase of the Director of Financial Services position to permanent full-time
- announced the finding that there were no conflicts of interest found for any current member of Council that would prevent them from participating in and voting on a decision to accept water from Nanaimo as it relates to the Lantzville/Nanaimo Water Agreement
- approved a Development Variance Permit for a workshop/storage building and existing woodshed building at 7705 Lantzville Road
- gave OCP & Zoning Amendment Bylaws 50.7 & 60.33 (for 7491 Lantzville Road) two readings, and scheduled the public hearing for 7:00 pm, Monday, November 14th at the District Office
- gave Regional Parks & Trails Parcel Tax & Assessment Roll Preparation Bylaw No. 133 three readings
- awarded the asphalt replacement contract for \$214,231 to Lafarge Canada Inc. for Bayview Park Drive (asphalt) and Manhattan Drive (chipseal)
- appointed Fred Manson as Interim CAO (and other statutory roles) effective September 28, 2016
- authorized the Lantzville Volunteer Firefighters Association to hold the annual bonfire and fireworks celebration on the District's tennis court property on School Road on Monday, October 31, 2016 from approximately 6:00 pm to 10:00 pm.

Free Children's Cycling Safety Clinics

Taught by the Greater Nanaimo Cycling Coalition, coordinated and funded through the District of Lantzville, Grades 3/4 children will enjoy 8 hours of *free* instruction to improve cycling safety and bike knowledge. Sessions include riding in Huddlestone Park and on Lantzville Rd. Prerequisites: able to ride a bike, bike is in good working order and fits child, has and wearing a well-fitted helmet at all times, and ideally no BMX bikes. Parent participation is greatly encouraged. Rotary Park – Under Construction!

BYLAW REMINDERS

Open Burning – Open burning is closed through to and including October 15th, except with a permit for an incinerator fire, only permitted on Fridays and Saturdays if no ban is in place. From October 16, 2016 to May 14, 2017, residents are permitted to burn in their backyards without a permit as long as they follow the conditions and requirements. Questions? Fireworks – Prepare for a safe and Happy Hallowe'en! Please remember that within the District of Lantzville:

- no person under the age of 18 is permitted to possess fireworks
- the sale of fireworks and use of firecrackers are prohibited
- except for setting off fireworks on October 31st from 9:00 am – 11:00 pm, you must obtain a District of Lantzville Special Use Fireworks Permit *BEFORE* setting off fireworks. Apply to the District, at least 3 business days in advance, for permit approval by the Fire Chief; special requirements may be added.
- Fines start at \$150.00

Traffic Notes – In October, the District of Lantzville will be replacing asphalt for Bayview Park Drive. Community Water System Maintenance

The District's fire hydrants are scheduled for annual maintenance starting October 3rd. Your regular collection day changes when there is a statutory holiday. After the garbage and food waste collection on Friday, October 7th, collection resumes on Monday, October 17th with recycling and food waste pick-up, and continues on Mondays until Remembrance Day after which pick-up will be on Tuesdays.
