## Traffic Notes – Temporary Road Closure!

A portion of Lantzville Road (north of Ware Road to Huddlestone Road) will be closed from 9:45 am to 11:00 am Saturday, September 9, 2017 for the Minetown Day parade. Traffic control will be present during the closure to redirect traffic through Lantzville via alternate routes. Expect traffic delays, obey all directions given by traffic control, and please use caution with the increased pedestrian traffic.

## Property Taxes

**Have you paid your Property Taxes and Claimed your Home Owner Grant?** – Property Taxes were due July 4, 2017. A 5% penalty on outstanding balances has been applied and a further 5% penalty will be applied on October 2, 2017.

**Tax Sale on September 25, 2017** – Property tax accounts with three years of unpaid taxes as of the last Monday in September must be sold at tax sale which, if required, will take place in the Council Chambers, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, 7192 Lantzville Road, Lantzville, BC on Monday, September 25<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 am. Properties in a tax sale are advertised in the newspaper.

**Parcel Tax Refund** – If, for the years 2003-2015, you were the owner of a manufactured home identified on the list of impacted properties, you may be eligible for a Parcel Tax Refund. Visit [www.lantzville.ca](http://www.lantzville.ca) for additional information.

## Home Owner Grant Refund Program
