RDN Releases 2025 Curbside Collection Calendar

The Regional District of Nanaimo has released the 2025 Curbside Collection Calendar. Also, the Regional District of Nanaimo is taking the next step towards achieving 90% waste diversion from the landfill: A Mandatory Waste Source Separation bylaw is coming into effect January 2025. This means that if you live, work or have a business in Lantzville, you will be required to separate out recyclables and organics from your garbage.

Notice of Public Hearing for Bylaw No. 380

The District of Lantzville Council will hold an electronic public hearing as part of the regular Council meeting on Wednesday, December 4, 2024 at 6:00 pm, virtual (Zoom Webinar platform) and livestreamed at lantzville.ca to receive and consider input from all persons who believe that their interest in property is affected by proposed "District of Lantzville Official Zoning Bylaw No. 180, 2020, Amendment (7101 Stevens Place) Bylaw No. 380, 2024".

The purpose of the public hearing is to amend "District of Lantzville Zoning Bylaw No. 180, 2020" by rezoning the parcel legally described as: LOT 1, DISTRICT LOT 54, NANOOSE DISTRICT, PLAN 24258 (7101 Stevens Place) from "Residential 3" to "Park".
