

**DISTRICT OF LANTZVILLE
BYLAW NO. 197**

A BYLAW TO REALLOCATE RESERVE FUNDS

WHEREAS Section 188 of the *Community Charter* provides for the establishment of reserve funds by bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the District of Lantzville in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as “District of Lantzville Reserve Fund Reallocation (Facilities) Bylaw No. 197, 2019”.
2. That a reserve fund reallocation be hereby established under the provisions of Section 188 of the *Community Charter* to be known as the “Reserve Fund Reallocation (Facilities)”.
3. The following bylaws shall have opening balances as follows:

(d) Fire Hall Life Cycle Reserve Fund Bylaw No. 196, 2019.	\$672,899.46



