TOTAL FIRE BAN IN EFFECT

Effective: Noon, Tuesday, July 17, 2018

(Prohibition is in effect until public is otherwise notified)

Outdoor burning (including campfires) is **NOT** permitted on private and public property in the District of Lantzville. This means that any open flame of woody material, use of tiki torches, fireworks, burning barrels, and Category 2 & 3 open fires are prohibited.

Campfires on private and public property, beachfires, chimeas, and outdoor fireplaces have been added to the outdoor burning ban issued in May. Only devices using fuel that does not create sparks/embers (propane, natural gas, camp fuel or briquettes) will be allowed.

All outdoor burning including incinerators and campfires are strictly prohibited.

Please be aware that forest conditions are **extremely** dry.
