



## District of Lantzville Big Choices 2021 – 2023

April 28, 2021

*At its February 16, 2021 meeting Council addressed eight significant challenges facing the District. These steps will help Council move towards decisions for each of these challenges. These next steps are incorporated into the District of Lantzville Council Strategic Priorities 2021 – 2023 April 28, 2021.*

- 1. Child Care Space Creation Action Plan**  
**Next steps:**
  - Bring forward Childcare Action Plan for Council consideration on March 3, 2021.
  - Council requests staff to bring forward a report laying out options for childcare facilities in the District.
  - The report should include information regarding a stand alone facility on District property with the potential for use of upper floors for District uses.
  
- 2. District Facilities Planning**  
**Next steps:**
  - Council requests staff to bring forward a basic report regarding:
    - Community Use Building A (Costin Hall) and B (former church) repair cost estimates, and
    - potential for developer/new construction to contribute to the development of a community use facility.
  
- 3. Amenity Contribution Priorities**  
**Next steps:**
  - Council requests staff to bring forward a report regarding:
    - laying out a process whereby Council can establish priorities for community amenity contributions, and
    - providing advice from staff on recommended priorities.
  
- 4. OCP Timeline**  
**Next steps:**
  - Council to consider deferring a comprehensive review of the OCP to 2023 and in the short run consider minor amendments as needed.
  
- 5. Policing Reserve Fund**  
**Next steps:**
  - Remains to be considered by Council – in the near term Staff could bring forward an analysis of the need and costs of establishing a Policing Reserve Fund.
  
- 6. Age-friendly Action Plan**  
**Next steps:**
  - The Age-friendly Action Plan be referred to staff to provide a report with an implementation plan.
  
- 7. Committee Appointments**  
**Next steps:**
  - Appointments to the Parks and Trails Select Committee and Committee meetings be put on hold until COVID-19 emergency measures cease.
  
- 8. Economic Development**  
**Next steps:**
  - Apply to Island Coastal Economic Trust (ICET) for a \$70,000 Rural Business and Community Recovery Program Grant in order to support the 2018 Economic Development Strategy.
