District of Lantzville and CUPE Local 401 ratify five-year collective agreement

Lantzville, BC – The District of Lantzville and Canadian Union of Public Employees (CUPE) Local 401 are pleased to announce that we have concluded collective bargaining and have put in place a five-year collective agreement that provides stability for both the Municipality and the workforce.

Terms of the agreement ratified by Council and the CUPE Local 401 Lantzville members last week cover the period January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2022. The agreement includes increases to some of the annual limits on extended health benefits such as physiotherapy and vision care, a student employment plan for municipal projects, and wage increases of two per cent in each year plus an extra 1/4 per cent in the final year.

CUPE Local 401 represents approximately five full-time, one part-time and several casual workers employed in various jobs with the District of Lantzville, including public works, parks, administration and finance.

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
