Closed 'Lancewood' Path Access to Seaview Elementary School Field

Lantzville, BC – On Tuesday, January 31, 2023, Council received notification from Lantzville Projects Limited that fencing and 'No Trespassing Signage' would be erected on their properties at all access points located at both sides of Ware Road (Village South), Clark Drive West running along Bloods Creek to Alger Road (Clark Drive), and Ware Road and Philip Road and on both sides of Ronald Road (Medd Property) in order to prohibit unauthorized public access to the lands. This includes access at the rear of Seaview Elementary School, the paved pathway at the end of Lynn Drive at Lancewood Avenue where the pathway terminates at the private property.

In relation to the closure of the path located on the private property between the end of Lancewood Avenue and the Seaview Elementary School field, please be advised Council is aware and recognizes resident’s concerns, and the resulting disruption due to children and families no longer having access to this path to walk to and from Seaview Elementary School as they have done for decades. At present, your Council is actively working to resolve this issue, and will inform the community of updates as they become available.

The District of Lantzville Council considers it is in the public interest to respect no trespassing signage installed on private property.
