**Effective: Noon, Thursday, May 30, 2019**

(Prohibition in effect until Oct. 15, 2019 or until public is otherwise notified)

## **Category 2 OPEN FIRES PROHIBITED**

Category 2 Open Fires (Burn barrels, backyard burning, incinerators, burn piles, burning grass, fireworks, binary exploding targets, sky lanterns, outdoor burning, etc.) are **NOT** permitted on private and public property in the District of Lantzville.

Small contained campfires used for cooking, heating or ceremonial purposes are allowed (except on beaches) subject to the following:

- Must be contained in a device or fixture
- Campfire must be away from combustible materials
- Campfire is no larger than 0.61 metres (2 feet) by 0.61 metres (2 feet)
- Only propane, natural gas, charcoal or clean organic wood can be used; no branches, yard waste, or construction materials
- A responsible person must be in attendance at the campfire at all times, with a hand tool or at least eight litres of water available to properly extinguish the fire
- Ensure campfire is completely extinguished and ashes are cold to the touch before leaving the area for any length in time
- Be considerate of any neighbours when planning a campfire
- **NO OPEN AIR FIRES ARE PERMITTED ON ANY BEACH**
- Only portable propane campfire apparatus (CSA or ULC approved) are permitted on the beach between the hours of 11:00am to 8:00pm

**Please be aware that forest conditions are extremely dry.**
