NOTICE OF NOMINATION PERIOD

Public Notice is given that nominations will be received for candidates for the following District of Lantzville offices of:

Mayor — one (1) to be elected
Councillor — four (4) to be elected

All offices are four-year terms on the District of Lantzville Council.

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QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected and to hold office as a member of the District of Lantzville Council if the person:

- is 18 years of age or older on General Voting Day (October 17, 2026);
- is a Canadian citizen;
- has been a resident of British Columbia for at least six months immediately before the day the nomination documents are filed; and
- is not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in a local election in British Columbia or from being nominated for, elected to or holding the office, and is not otherwise disqualified by law.

CAMPAIGN PERIOD EXPENSE LIMITS

Under the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, the following limits apply during the campaign period, September 19 to October 17, 2026:

LIST OF REGISTERED VOTERS

From **Tuesday, September 1, 2026**, until the close of voting on Saturday, October 17, 2026, a copy of the List of Registered Electors will be available for public inspection at Municipal Hall, 7192 Lantzville Road, from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm, Monday to Friday, excluding statutory holidays.

Before inspecting the list, a person must sign a statement that the list and its information will be used only for purposes of Part 3 [Electors and Elections] of the *Local Government Act*.

An elector may submit a written request to the CEO to omit or obscure the elector’s address or other personal information from the list. Submit your written request to the CEO by email: vote@lantzville.ca or by letter before **Tuesday, August 18, 2026**.

ADVANCE ELECTOR REGISTRATION

Are you on the Voters List? The District uses the Provincial Voters List as the basis for its list of resident electors. Check or update your registration at elections.bc.ca. Elections BC’s deadline to register or update your information directly with Elections BC for this local election is **Tuesday, August 18, 2026**.

In addition, advance elector registration applications will be available at Municipal Hall and will remain available until **4:00 pm Tuesday, August 25, 2026**. Advance registration will be closed from **Wednesday, August 26, 2026, through Friday, October 16, 2026**. Eligible electors who are not registered in advance may still register at the voting place on Advance Voting Days and General Voting Day [October 7, 14 and 17, 2026].

OBJECTION TO REGISTRATION OF AN ELECTOR

An objection to a person shown on the List of Registered Electors must be made in writing by a person eligible to be registered as an elector of the District of Lantzville and received by the CEO before **4:00 pm Friday, September 11, 2026**. An objection may be made only on the basis that the person has died or is not qualified to be registered as an elector of the District of Lantzville.
