CAMPFIRE BAN LIFTED

Campfires on private and public property, beach fires, chimeas, and outdoor fireplaces used for cooking, heating or ceremonial purposes are now permitted, subject to the following:

- Fire is no larger than 1/2 metre by 1/2 metre in size
- Only clean wood can be used, no branches or yard waste (no pallets on beach!)
- A responsible person must be in attendance of the fire at all times, have a hand tool or at least eight litres of water available to properly extinguish the fire. Ensure fire is complete extinguished and ashes are cold to the touch before leaving the area for any length in time.
- The fire must be extinguished fully when done/before leaving
- Fire must be away from combustible materials
- Beach fires must be situated below the high-water mark
- Be considerate of any neighbours when planning a campfire/beach fire

CATEGORY 2 OPEN FIRES REMAIN PROHIBITED

Category 2 Open Fires (Burn barrels, backyard burning, incinerators, burn piles, burning grass, fireworks, binary exploding targets, sky lanterns, outdoor burning, etc.) are **NOT** permitted on private and public property in the District of Lantzville.

Please be aware that forest conditions are extremely dry.
