TOTAL FIRE BAN IN EFFECT

Effective: Noon, Tuesday, July 9, 2024

(Prohibition in effect until October 28, 2024 or until public is otherwise notified)

All outdoor burning and campfires are strictly prohibited on private or public property in the District of Lantzville.

This means Category 2 & 3 open fires and campfires are NOT permitted. (no use of burn barrels, open flame of woody material, backyard burning, incinerators, burn piles, burning grass, fireworks, binary exploding targets, use of tiki torches, sky lanterns, etc.)

Prohibition of campfires on private or public property, and outdoor fireplaces **have been added** to the outdoor burning ban issued in April.

Only devices using fuel that does not create sparks/embers (propane, natural gas, camp fuel or briquettes) will be allowed.

Please be aware that forest conditions are extremely dry.

Every person who ignites, or permits to be ignited, any fire, is responsible for that fire and is liable for all expenses incurred by the District to respond to that fire. NOTE: Cost recovery fees payable are in addition to any applicable violation fines.
